Moving from school can be hard

You could have questions like:

- What will I learn at work?
- Will I like it?
- What can I expect when I get to work?
- What type of work will I do?

You can get the answers to all these questions and more by taking part in Orana's Work Experience program. This program helps make the move from school to work easier.

The program helps you to learn and try a range of different jobs. You will be supported by a supervisor who will teach and support you in different work activities.



What will you gain from a Work Experience placement?

- New skills and confidence needed to enter the workforce
- Experience in a supported work environment
- Experience different work activities
- A supported pathway to move from school to work



Program Outline

- A tour of the work site including safety activities will be completed on your first day
- You will be provided with a Work Experience booklet to write information about your placement
- Goals for your placement will be set with the supervisor
- Workplace behaviours are discussed
- You will experience a range of work activities
- You will receive feedback halfway through and at the end of the placement
