Are you eligible?

To work at Orana you will need to be:

- Registered with Centrelink
- Receiving or qualify for a Disability Support Pension
- Able to work safely in a commercial environment
- Be keen and motivated to work
- Want to work as part of a team

If yes, what's the next step?

- Contact our Intake Coordinator and we will organise a time to talk to you about your options.
- A three month paid work trial will be organised in a safe and supportive environment so you can feel comfortable with your work. These trials can be part time to suit your needs, or full time if you would prefer.
- On-the-job training will be provided, so no prior experience is necessary.
- Support Coordination can be provided if needed.
